#### **Staying Healthy**

The arrival of autumn brings the "birthday season" to my family. When my son and daughter were young children, they loved their annual parties and presents; they were not as fond of their yearly medical

checkups! However, the examinations were vital to keeping Joshua and Hope healthy. The annual measurement of growth in height, weight, and developmental skills was particularly important. We knew that, if our kids were healthy, growth would occur naturally. If a lack of growth was detected, their doctor would work to locate unhealthy obstacles to their development and would seek to address them immediately.

Rick Warren, author of the best-seller <u>The Purpose-Driven Life</u>, wrote an earlier book entitled <u>The Purpose-Driven Church</u>. In that book, Warren writes that many congregations spend their time asking, "What will *make* our church grow?" However, he sees the key question to be raised by church leaders as, "What is *keeping* our church from growing?" After all, the church is "the body of Christ," a living organism, intended to grow "as God causes it to grow" (Colossians 2.19 NIV). Therefore, the challenge facing congregations is the need to focus on being healthy *spiritually* in order to grow *naturally*.

There is good news here for us as we navigate the difficult challenges of 21st-century American culture. God WANTS His church to grow! God has DESIGNED His church to grow! God gives His church the ABILITY to grow! The part we play in church growth is simply this: we must "stay in shape" spiritually by removing unhealthy attitudes, habits, and lifestyles and by exercising the disciplines of prayer, Bible study, Christian fellowship, giving of talents and resources, and faithful acts of sacrificial outreaching love in and through Jesus. The benefits of staying healthy will be enormous...naturally!


### ANNUAL CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING
