### **We Are Now Livestreaming!**

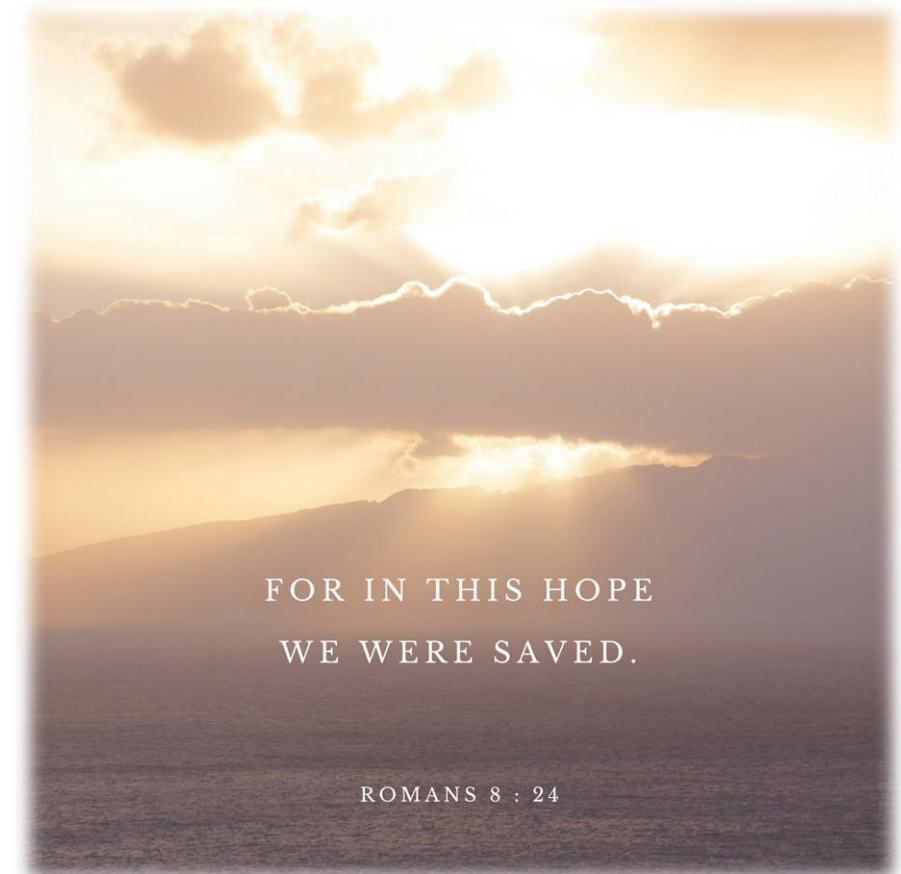
