If anyone is willing to assist with Youth activities and meetings, Josh could use your help. Please let Josh Marlowe know of your availability to assist.

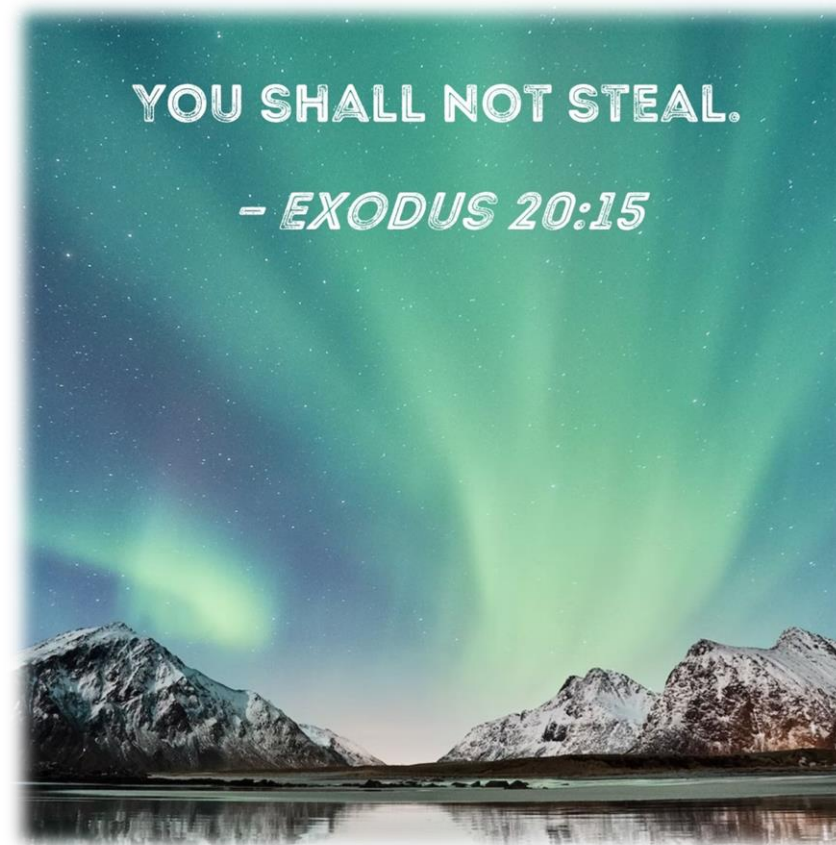
